



SEERKHAZI S. GOVINDARAJAN



I present to you, Madam, Seerkhazi S. Govindarajan.
Born in 1933 Shri Govindarajan had his formal training in music at the Tamil Isai Sangam and Central College of Karnatak Music, Madras. Later, he was groomed by renowned flute Vidwan Prof. Thiruppampuram and Swaminatha Pillai. His style is notable for clear diction and subtle nuances, deepened by a sonorous voice. He has given concerts in almost all important cities of India.
In recognition of his services to Karnatak Music Shri Govindarajan received many titles and awards, including "Kaleimaman" from Tamil Nadu Eyal Isai Nataka Manram and "Sangeet Vidwan" from Central College of Karnatak Music, Madras. As a Fellow of the U.G.C. he was Professor of Indian Vocal Music in Madras University.
Shri Govindarajan has a number of L.P. discs to his credit and has toured many countries on concert assignments.
For his eminence in Vocal Music and his contribution to its enrichment Seerkhazi Shri S. Govindarajan receives the Sangeet Natak Akademi Award for Karnatak Vocal Music for 1980.
