



R. N. DORESWAMY

Akademi Award : Carnatic Instrumental Music (Veena)

Born in 1916 in Rudrapattana, Karnataka, Shri R.N. Doreswamy received his training in the Veena under V. Venkatagiriappa and in vocal music from Salem Doreswamy Iyengar. He represents the Mysore style of Veena music.

Shri R.N. Doreswamy has served as Professor of Veena at the University College of Fine Arts, Mysore University, and at Maharani's College, Mysore. For his outstanding musicianship, he was appointed Asthana Vidwan of the Mysore Palace. He is also an accomplished composer, and has many publications on music to his credit.

Shri Doreswamy has received various honours for his service to music. The Government of Karnataka has conferred on him the Rajyotsava Award (1989), and the Karnataka State Sangeet Nritya Academy has bestowed upon him the Karnataka Kala Tilakam award (1983).

Shri R.N. Doreswamy receives the Sangeet Natak Akademi Award for his contribution to Carnatic instrumental music.
